The Byers-Evens House Museum is pleased to offer a hands-on school program designed for 3rd and 4th grade students. In "An Afternoon into the Past," students role-play characters based on real-life Evans family members and friends from the year 1918. The class explores the historic home with an expertly trained guide, who helps students foster a hands-on understanding life in early Denver. Dressed in costume, each student becomes a teacher as they tell their classmates about their character, and perform an activity in the house with "please touch" artifacts. This tour brings history to life with engaging activities that align to state standards.
