Internship Title: History Colorado Design and Production Internship

Stipend: This is a competitive internship position with a \$1000 stipend. Qualified candidates may receive academic credit through their college or university.

Desired Schedule: February 2016 – June 2019. Minimum 10-16 hours/week, 2 days/week. Intern must be available to work on two days of their choice Tuesday – Thursday between 9am-4pm.

Broad Scope of Position: The Design and Production Intern will work as part of a team that constructs, installs, and maintains museum exhibits. The intern will learn best practices and museum standards for design and fabrication by assisting design and production staff in preparing exhibits, making props, and learning trade techniques. Interns will be given the opportunity to exercise and strengthen their existing skills, to develop new skills of exhibit-making, and to exercise responsibility, creativity, and imagination.

Outcomes: The internship will teach the intern new techniques for fabrication, handle new materials, and build their professional museum installation experience.
