Abstract	This collection is primarily composed of photographs taken by David DeHarport (1921-2000), a Colorado-born archaeologist and fine art photographer, and also includes his diaries, notes, and correspondence.

Biographical note

David Lee DeHarport was a photographer and anthropologist primarily known for his photographic work in Colorado's eastern plains region and his archaeological survey work of Arizona's Canyon de Chelly National Monument. He was born in Denver, Colorado on August 8, 1921 to Carolina Hamilton DeHarport (b. 1890) and Leander Adarian DeHarport (1879-1961). He had one sister, Charlotte Eliza DeHarport (1924-2002). DeHarport attended the University of Denver and studied photography and anthropology. After earning his B.A. in 1943, he received a Master's in anthropology in 1945.

After graduation, he started a PhD at Harvard University. The Peabody Museum sponsored DeHarport to work at Canyon de Chelly National Monument during his PhD candidacy. He spent the summers of 1948-1951 and 1957-1959 surveying the Monument. DeHarport would later go on to write a four volume dissertation entitled, "An Archeological Survey of Canyon de Chelly," based on data gathered 367 sites in Canyon de Chelly. It included 2,600 photographs of petroglyphs that DeHarport started taking in 1959 with a Leica 35mm camera.

DeHarport held numerous jobs that would inform his later work. In 1953, he photographed low-relief sculpture at Chichen Itza, in the Yucatán Peninsula, in Mexico with the Carnegie Institute. In 1955, DeHarport again put his doctoral studies at Harvard on hold to spend several months photographing sites in India's Ajanta Caves on behalf of UNESCO.

After completing his PhD, DeHarport took a position with the Navajo Claims Commission in Winslow, Arizona. In 1962, DeHarport began work as a research associate at the Museum of Northern Arizona, during which time he returned to Canyon de Chelly to document archaeological sites.

In 1963, DeHarport dedicated himself full time to art photography, chiefly shooting the landscapes of the Southwest. In the early 1980's, he began working with fellow photographer, Bill O'Connor, to document all of Canyon de Chelly's rock art in both black-and-white and color. This project continued into the early 1990's, and the two photographers mounted exhibitions of their work at the Denver Art Museum and Denver's Native American Trading Company. During the late 1980's, DeHarport's interest also turned toward eastern Colorado, a subject close to the photographer's heart. The DeHarport family had lived on the Eastern Plains for nearly 100 years.[3] In the late 1980's, DeHarport and fellow photographer, Marscha Winterfield, began exploring and photographing the towns and landscapes of the region. These efforts culminated in "Last Chance to Cope." Winterfield and DeHarport hoped this series would draw more attention to Colorado's plains region, an area of Colorado that the artists felt was often overlooked in favor of the state's mountainous regions. DeHarport dedicated the rest of his life to fine art photography.

David DeHarport died in Colorado in 2001. He was survived by his sister, Charlotte.

Scope and Contents note

This collection contains gelatin silver prints, 120mm and 35mm negatives, and slides taken by David DeHarport (1921-2001) between 1939-2000 in various regions of the United States, primarily Colorado and the Southwest, as well as international locations such as India, Mexico, and Canada. DeHarport, an archaeologist and fine art photographer, initially used photography as survey tool in archaeological work and later as a means of artistic self-expression. Images depict natural landscapes in areas such as Arches National Park in Utah and Death Valley National Park in California, as well as Ancestral Puebloan sites in Canyon de Chelly in Arizona and sites in Chichen Itza in Yucatan, Mexico. DeHarport's fine-art photography work in eastern Colorado makes up the bulk of the collection. These photographic materials depict farmland, Colorado ghost towns, abandoned buildings, and roadside signage. The collection also contains manuscript materials dating from 1923-2001, including DeHarport's diaries, correspondence, and notes, as well as materials created by DeHarport family members, including music written and collected by his aunt Teresita Ryder DeHarport (1882-1972) and uncles Horatio Wheaton DeHarport (b. 1864), Theodore Wheaton DeHarport (1859-1935), all of whom were musicians in Denver in the 19th and early 20th centuries.

Scope and Contents note

Dating from 1923-2001, this series includes David DeHarport's appointment book, correspondence, diaries, drafts and notes, exhibition labels, field notes, a savings account book, and news clippings. DeHarport's dairies are particularly of note for their completeness, as he used his diaries to document many of his shots, and dates on negatives in the collection's photographic series often correspond with diary entries. In addition, a school note book that belonged to Charlotte Eliza DeHarport (1924-2002), David DeHarport's sister, is also included in this series. Other DeHarport family papers in this series include published and unpublished music for the guitar, banjo, and mandoline composed and arranged by Theodore Wheaton DeHarport (1859-1935) and Horatio Wheaton DeHarport (b. 1864), David DeHarport's uncles. Teresita Ryder DeHarport (1872-1882), David DeHarport's aunt, also shared a talent for music, and a piano method book for popular music by her appears in this series.

This subseries contains photographs, negatives, and slides shot by David DeHarport in the United States from 1939-2000. States represented in this subseries include Arizona, California, Colorado, Illinois, Maine, Massachusetts, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Texas, Utah, and Wyoming. Many of the photographs feature stark desert and plains landscapes, abandoned structures, and roadside signage. In addition, a number of photographs this series depict Ancestral Puebloan dwellings and rock art; DeHarport's photographs of Canyon de Chelly National Monument, a spot he photographed multiple times throughout his life, are a prime example. It is important to note that a few divergences from DeHarport's typical subjects exist in this series. For instance during his studies at Harvard, DeHarport would often shoot the local Community Boat Club for practice; he was particularly interested in the shapes made by the boats' bodies and sails. In addition, DeHarport's fascination with shape and form carried over to some of his work with airplanes; shots from Denver's Stapleton Airport and Aurora's Sky Ranch Airport appear throughout this series.
