The collection contains four items, three of which are original pieces. The fourth item is an index as described below.

1. Colorado Supreme Court, July 10, 1861 – February 10, 1868.

A record book containing the rules and regulations of the Court adopted in July 1861. The book also contains resolutions passed by the Denver Bar as well as notes, minutes, and cases as documented in meetings in both Denver and Golden.

The book is 256 pages in length with handwritten notes on pages 1-213. The cover is loose from the spine. Formerly cataloged as a book: RB 342.2 C714 Ci.

A single document, Rule 4, states that attorneys bearing the appropriate diplomas may practice law in the Territory. Rule 4 also appears on page 10 of the Colorado Supreme court record book.

4. Roll of Attorneys, 1872-1875, 1933

A register book listing practicing attorneys. Inclusive dates run from March 30, 1872 to November 13, 1933. The book is 248 in length; however, only thirteen pages show entries as follows:
