COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

Collection Name: Como Iron, Coal and Land Company

Title: Records, 1881-1902

Extent: .25 linear feet (15 pieces)

Historical Note: The Como Iron, Coal, and Land Company was organized in 1881 and located in the Tarryall Mining District of Park County, Colorado. The principle ore mined was iron from claims situated in Mineral Hill. Capital stock was valued at \$1 million divided into ten-thousand shares at one-hundred dollars each. In 1895, the Como properties were incorporated into the Mineral Hill Mining and Milling Company.

Scope and Contents: The collection contains an undated handwritten report describing company property, ore analyses, and a description of work in process. Also contained in the book are a report on coal lands owned by Joseph E. Bates and the State Land Improvement Company dated 1893 and an undated report concerning the formation and proposed work of the Mineral Hill Tunnel and Mining Company. The collection also includes a photocopy of the Mineral Hill Company certificate of incorporation.
