

Mss 185 DeLong, Horace Tool (1860-1933)

The collection of newspaper clippings and ephemera were presented to the society by the Estate of State Senator Horace Tool DeLong in July 1935.

The collection contains hundreds of newspaper clippings from Colorado newspapers with specific dates written on most. Half of the collection represents Western Slope material (fruit farming, dry farming, irrigation, etc.), obituaries of prominent Colorado pioneers and the Methodist Episcopal Church of Colorado. Several file folders contain printed programs of Sunday School oration contests sponsored by the DeLong brothers.

Headings used for the file folders are those used by Senator DeLong for his one volume "scrapbook" that contained the loose clippings in separate dividers.
