Abstract

Scrapbooks, correspondence, and related materials belonging to Winifred Gordon a resident of Central City.

Background Note

Winifred Gordon was a resident of Central City and rented her properties to Central City Opera participants. The scrapbooks are composed of newspaper clippings (mostly from the Register-Call) relating to Central City the Opera, and Baby Doe Tabor; Opera programs, personal correspondence, and Junior High Home Economics Tests.

Scope and Content

The collection is composed largely of scrapbooks ranging from 1935-1968. It is arranged roughly chronologically and by subject. The collection includes correspondence, news clippings and scrapbooks Central City
