Abstract

The son of William H. James, pioneer Colorado banker and smelter magnate, Harry C. James was president of the Yak Mining and Milling Co., and a director of numerous corporations, including the Denver National Bank, the Denver Gas and Electric Co., and the Colorado Portland Cement Co.

This collection contains 3 large account books of Harry C. James. The collection also contains two scrapbooks, one contains photographs of the James family and the other reports on the Constitutional Convention of Colorado held in 1876.
