William Kelly was an prominent water lawyer in Colorado. Born in Mound City, Missouri February 22, 1883, he received his law degree from the University of Colorado in 1907, and, in 1941, opened a law partnership with E. Tyndall Snyder in Greeley, Colorado. Kelly argued several landmark water rights cases in Colorado, including the famous Wyoming v. Colorado Supreme Court water rights case ~~in~~ (1930 ~~to~~ 1937). He was instrumental in drafting legislation for the Colorado-Big Thompson Project, and wrote many articles and monographs on water rights in Colorado.

The collection spans 1910 to 1969, and its series include: 1. St. John's Missionary College Material (1928-1959), 2. Reports & Printed Material (1922-1969), and 3. Bound Volumes (1910-1934). The provenance of the collection is unknown. An inventory is available in the repository.

The Greeley Library and Museum have several items relating to William Kelly, including the book, A Conversation with William R. Kelly, esq., which is based on sixty hours of oral interviews with Kelly.
