Abstract

This collection contains memoirs, notebooks, scrapbooks and photo albums of Quantrille Day McClung, Denver resident, author and librarian. McClung was born March 3, 1890 in Denver. She started working at the Denver Public Library in 1911, a graduate of the first training course. She retired in 1947 and subsequently spent much of her time doing genealogical research. She produced several books of Colorado genealogy including two volumes of the Carson-Bent-Boggs genealogies. McClung died on July 3, 1985 at the age of 95.
