Abstract

Guy Winters McCreery was a member of Company M, First Colorado Volunteer Infantry and was stationed at Camp Merritt in San Francisco, California and later in Manila, Philippines during the Spanish-American War.

This collection contains eight letters written by McCreery to his family while he was stationed in California awaiting deployment to the Philippines. Also included is one letter relating McCreery's deployment and one letter recounting some of his time spent in Manila. This collection also contains one broadside and a series of news clippings relating to the troops.
