Abstract	John P. Heisler (Oct. 13, 1847-Nov. 7, 1908) an attorney from Knox County, Ohio oversaw many land claims in Colorado. The collection focuses around land claims he oversaw with The Altura Park and Reservoir Company through stock certificates, check deposits, and business correspondence. Heisler would hold positions in both Colorado and United States government assemblies dying from disease.

Biographical/Historical note

The collection focuses around John P. Heisler (October 13, 1847-November 7, 1908) a lawyer from Knox County, Ohio. He moved to Colorado on July 16, 1870 with the engineer corps of Kansas Pacific Road to build railroads. Heisler would later graduate from law school joining the bar with the firm of Benedict & Stone. In 1892 he would be elected to the House of General Assembly overlooking funding of schools and universities along with rights to property. During his life Heisler held many positions in Colorado and United States Political Office and government. He would die from disease leaving behind one brother and two sisters being considered one of Denver's most capable and efficient attorneys.
