**Abstract** On August 13, 1912, Glen Rogers became the first person in Colorado to hold an amateur radio license. During his career he sold radios and did recording work. This collection contains Rogers' radio license and three report cards from Manual Training High School. This collection also contains unprocessed black and white photographs.

## **Biographical note**

---

Glen Rogers was born on August 15, 1895, in Ypsilanti, Michigan to Albert S. (1866-1932) and Sarah A. (1871-?) Rogers. At a young age, Glen and his family moved to Denver, Colorado in the hopes of improving Glen's asthma. Rogers attended Manual Training High School from 1910-1913, taking courses in the arts and math. During this time, Glen built his own radio station which became operational on November 18, 1914.

After graduating high school, Glen enlisted and served in the Navy during World War II. He served on the USS Idaho.

After the war, Glen became an electrical contractor and sold radios. As technology began to advance his interests moved his interests from selling radios to recording.

Glen Rogers passed away on May 20, 1957 from respiratory problems.
