Biographical note

Ellen Kingman Fisher (1941-) is a long-time member of History Colorado and one of only two women to serve as History Colorado's Chair of the Board of Directors. She holds a PhD in History from CU Boulder and is a historian and published author. Her accomplishments include the publication of histories of the Junior League of Denver, a biography of Nathaniel P. Hill, and a history of the Public Service Company of Colorado, which contributed to the successful completion of her PhD.

Scope and Contents note

This collection consists of personal correspondence between Ellen Fisher and her friends and family. Topics discussed in the correspondence include subjects related to family well-being, trips, marriages, births, and daily activities. Each year of correspondence contains Christmas letters that highlight exciting events from the previous year for Ellen Fisher's family, extended family, and friends. Included in the Christmas greetings are pictures of family members, tracking how they have grown over the years. The majority of the correspondence are emails and Christmas correspondence that was mailed; original envelopes were not retained.
