Abstract	<p>Anne Waring Maer (1924-2012) is a third generation Coloradan. Her family were 1860 pioneers in Colorado and were involved in civic and entrepreneurial ventures in Denver. Some civic organizations they were involved in was Denver Botanic Gardens, Denver Nature and Science Museum, and the Colorado Symphony. Her mom, Ruth Porter, cofounded the Graland Country Day School and her dad, James Waring, was Chief of Medecine at the University of Colorado Medical School. This collection contains correspondence for Anne Waring Maer and Ruth Porter, family papers, school year book, and chapters and books written by and about family members. This collection gives insight into generations of pioneering Coloradans and the legacy they have left through their business and civic operations.</p>

Biographical Note

Anne Waring was born on April 7, 1924 in Denver, Colorado to Ruth Porter (1889-1992) and James J. Waring (1883-1962). She is the third generation to be born in Colorado. Anne attended Graland Country Day School, which her mother co-founded. She continued her education at Mt. Vernon Seminary in Washington, D.C. and graduated from Wellesley College in 1945. After graduating, Anne taught at Graland Country Day School for ten years. In 1955 she married Edward D. White Jr. whom she had two sons with, Edward D. "Ted" and James "Jamie" Waring.

In 1971, Anne married a second time to Claude Maer. Once married to Claude, the couple traveled extensively throughout Europe, Africa, and Asia. She died in 2012 and is buried at Fairmont Cemetery, Denver, Colorado.

Historical Note

Anne Waring Maer's mother, Ruth Porter, was part of a pioneer family in Denver, Colorado. The Porters arrived in Colorado in 1860 and became involved in the establishment of many businesses and civic centers in Denver. Some corporations they were involved in are: the first telephone company of Denver, ranches in Colorado and New Mexico, Denver Sanitary and Fertilizing Company, Porter Hospital, Denver Botanic Gardens, Denver Museum of Nature and Science, Colorado Symphony, Webb-Waring Institute, and Graland Country Day School.
