**Abstract** Ted White's family has been a key figure in the development of Colorado, dating back to 1860. As a member of a pioneering family, Ted is involved with several civic and medical organizations his family was involved with: Denver Botanic Gardens and the Webb-Waring Institute. As of 2015, Ted was as a business attorney and strategist at Moye White, LLP. This collection contains professional reports and correspondence for Ted and his dad, Edward D. White, Jr. Also included are Ted's academic assignments, report cards, and his senior report. A scrapbook highlights his parents and his youth in Denver, and included is information related to his mom's, Anne Waring Maer, charity work.

## Historical note

---

John W. Smith and his family first traveled to Colorado in 1860 from Kansas with supplies for a general store and mills. After settling in Colorado, John became a central figure in Colorado during its development through business, politics, and civic opportunities. John was associated with other Denver figures such as: J.K. Mullen, Elia Ammons, John Evans, W.S. Cheesman, and David Moffat. One of John's daughters, Laura, married Henry Porter.

Laura and Henry married in 1874. Henry Porter was a merchant, banker, and businessman in Denver. He was involved with the development of telegraph lines between Denver and Mexico. At this time he also promoted the Denver & Pacific Railway, Denver National Bank, and Colorado Fuel & Iron. One of Laura and Henry's daughters, Ruth, married James J. Waring (1883-1962).

Once recovering from tuberculosis, James J. Waring became a practicing physician. He taught at the University of Colorado School of Medicine and co-founded the Webb-Waring Lung Institute (1924). Their daughter Anne married Edward D. White, Jr.

Edward D. White, Jr. was a Denver architect. Edward and Anne had two sons, Ted and Jamie White.

## Biographical note

---

Ted White is the fourth generation to be born in Colorado. He was born to Anne Waring Maer and Edward D. White, Jr. He attended Graland Country Day School which his Grandma, Ruth Porter, co-founded. After elementary school he attended Kent Denver School and graduated from New York University School of Law. Returning to Colorado, Ted became a business attorney. As of 2015, he worked for Moye White, LLP.
