Additionally, the costs for easements and covenants prior to FY2004 are not included in these calculations, and amounts may change if grant awards are declined or rescinded in the future. Due to a new formula for tallying the total numbers of successful grants from SHF's inception, some numbers may vary from those reported prior to 2011.
