

Visitor Rules and Expectations

1. Food and Drink

Eating and drinking are prohibited in museum galleries. The History Colorado Center does provide tables to place your drink outside galleries, or you can put any of your belongings in our lockers on the Ground Floor. Our cafe is open 8:00 am to 4 pm on weekdays and 9:30 am to 4 pm on weekends. There are tables throughout the museum where you can enjoy your picnic or sack lunch.

2. Photography and Video

Bring a camera! There will be opportunities for photography. With the exception of reporters on assignment escorted by staff, cameras must be handheld and no flash photography or tripods are allowed.

3. Touching

The History Colorado Center has several hands-on and interactive elements inside the exhibitions. Guests are welcome to touch any interactive that isn't behind glass or out of reach. Please respect our artifacts and don't touch our cases. If you're unsure, please ask a staff member.

4. Horseplay

Running, shoving, pushing and other physical activity can damage museum artifacts. Or if you act in a certain way that makes staff or visitors feel unsafe. Please be respectful of our space.

Unaccompanied Children

Children (11 and younger) must be accompanied by an adult during their museum visit. Individuals 12 and older are welcome in the museum without parental supervision.

6. Pets

Pets are not allowed in the museum. Only service dogs are allowed.

History Colorado reserves the right to immediately evict from the museum premises any visitor who does not adhere to the rules above.
