Internship Title: Museum Education Internship

Internship Location: Trinidad History Museum, Trinidad, CO

Stipend: \$2,000. The stipend is not salary or compensation. The stipend is meant to support study and research during the tenure of the appointment and will be issued upon completion of the internship.

Desired Schedule: 5-10 hours/week (for a total of 150 hours), May-August 2024.

Broad Scope of Position: The intern will assist our Education Coordinator with research, capacity building, and facilitation of programming at the Trinidad History Museum (which features the historic Bloom Mansion, Baca House, Baca-Bloom Heritage Gardens, and the Santa Fe Trail Museum). The ideal candidate must be comfortable working with primary and secondary sources to create educational programming for adult and youth audiences and be comfortable working with K12 students. Through this internship, the intern will gain practical experience in the museum education field and have the opportunity to create and facilitate their own programming and curriculum.

Outcomes: During the internship, the intern will build skills communicating with audiences of small and mid-sized museums and have the ability to experiment and develop new techniques in a collaborative and supportive environment.
