

Autobees, Jose Mariano

Jose Mariano Autobees, who also went by the name Mariano Autobees, lived in Huerfano, Colorado and was commissioned a 2nd Lieutenant in 1864 in Company H, 3rd Colorado Volunteer Cavalry. He apparently served as a scout during the Indian wars and later opened a Trading Post near Pueblo. The information provided by his great granddaughter in 1951 pertains mainly to audit reports and quarterly returns.
