

ATCHISON TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILROAD

The Atchison and Topeka Railroad was organized in 1859 and the name was changed to the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe in 1863. Construction started in 1869, and generally followed the Arkansas River to La Junta where it branches; one branch going to Albuquerque and the other to Denver.
