Colorado Academy

Colorado Academy was founded in Denver's Capital hill neighborhood in 1906 under the name Hill School for Boys. In 1923 it transitioned to the Colorado Military School, introducing military courses to the curriculum. By World War II, the school had outgrown its location and moved to its current location in south Denver. The school sits on a wooded 95 acre lot originally owned by Jesse Welborn, the president of the Colorado Fuel and Iron Company in 1947. In 1955, the Academy shifted its academic focus from military training to a college preparatory school for boys. In 1971, the school became coeducational. Colorado Academy is an independent school with a curriculum focused on liberal arts and science.

Scope and Contents note

This collection contains stories written by third grade students of Colorado Academy, located in south Denver, explaining how students' families came to live in Colorado. Included in the stories are pictures of the student who wrote the story, a brief paragraph summarizing their story, and at least one typed page of their family's history. Many of these stories describe the students moving to Colorado in the 1990s, but some students' families came to Colorado in the 1800s. This school project was initiated by the class's teacher, Susan Andrews, and highlights the students' awareness and understanding of their presence in Colorado.

The collection contains two binders from the school year 2005 and 2007.
