Abstract	<p>This collection contains a Bank of Telluride check register used by the Emma Gold Mining Company circa 1901-1909. Gold was discovered in Telluride, Colorado, in 1858. The first claim was made in 1875 and a settlement in Telluride soon followed. In 1881 a toll road was built into Telluride and in 1891 the Rio Grande Southern Railway built a railroad line to Telluride. Routes into Telluride brought an influx of people prior to the Panic of 1893. Labor disputes slowed down production of Telluride mines. Mining companies began to consolidate mines from 1939-1953. During the 1960s and 1970s the remainder of mines in Telluride closed. The Emma Gold Mining company had an office located in Denver, Colorado.</p>
