Blake Street is named after Charles Blake who was a member of General William Larmier's party who participated in the founding of Denver. Blake Street was a principle commercial thoroughfare in the early years of Denver containing commission and auction houses, animal corrals, and businesses. As Denver grew, the commercial center shifted away from the center of the city, and Blake Street suffered a decline. Today, Blake Street is being restored as part of Denver's urban renewal of its lower downtown.

The collection contains photocopies of Abstracts of Titles for properties bounded by Wazee Street, Blake Street, Fifteenth Street, and Cherry Creek.
