Edward Burnett was a writer of his memories in the frontier west. He wrote articles that were published regarding histories of Wyoming, particularly of ranching and cattle raising. He also wrote numerous works on incidents and encounters he had or had knowledge of in Montana, Wyoming and Northern Colorado.

The collection contains: Correspondence (1937); Literary Material (1932-1936), containing most of Burnett's unpublished stories; Printed Material (1935-1937), including articles that were published; and Miscellaneous Material (1918).

The provenance of the collection is unknown.
