Biographical/Historical note

Zella Bucher (March 21, 1918-October 28, 1997) from Keota, Colorado is the wife of Anthony Joyce (June 18, 1916-April 1, 2008) of Pine Bluffs, Wyoming. The two leave behind four children: Jerome, Mary Ann, Bill, and Ellen along with eight grandchildren. Obtaining no higher than a High School diploma, Zella lettered in basketball and went on to be a housewife to her self-employed husband, Anthony. Much of Zella's life focuses around the importance of sports at her High School and growing up in rural Keota, Colorado.

The Zella Bucher & Family Collection consists of Keota articles, Keota High School letter certificate, photographs, certificates and ribbons, High School diploma, graduation announcement, postcard album, and two scrapbooks.
